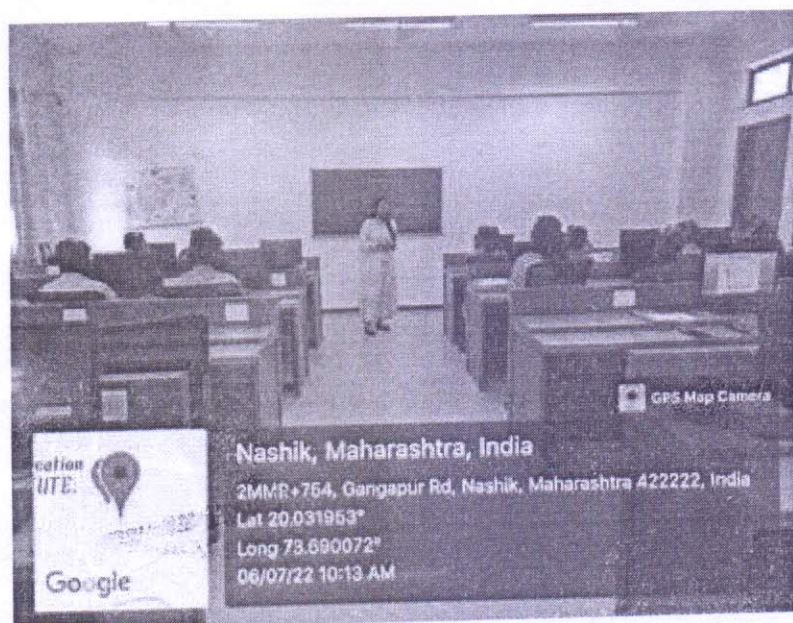
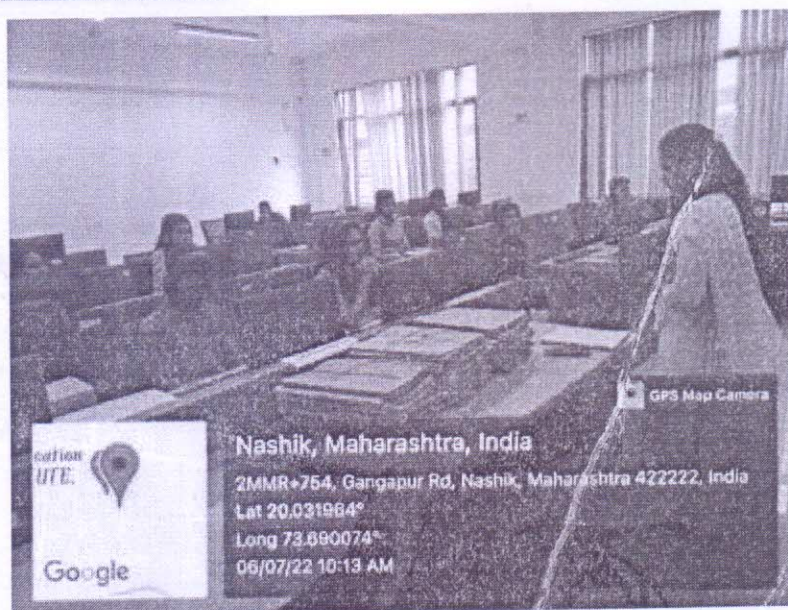
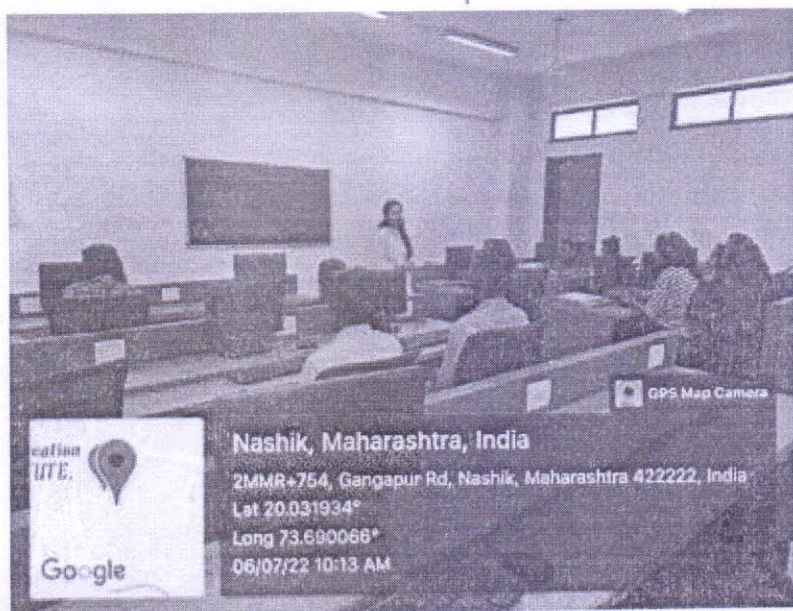
For improvement of soft skills and English speaking for first year students we have provided English lab with ETNL facilities under Applied Sciences and Humanities Department (First year Engineering).
