Road Safety





Road Safety



Road transport remains the least safe mode of transport, with road accidents representing the main cause of death of people. The boom in the vehicle population without adequate road infrastructure, poor attention to driver training and unsatisfactory regulation has been responsible for increase in the number of accidents. India's vehicle population is negligible as compared to the World statistics but the comparable proportion for accidents is substantially large.

The need for stricter enforcement of law to ensure greater safety on roads and an environment friendly road transport operation is of paramount importance. Safety and security are growing concerns for businesses, governments and the traveling public around the world, as also in India. It is, therefore, essential to take new initiatives in raising awareness, skill and knowledge of students as one of the ibid stake holders who are expected to follow the rules and policies of the government in order to facilitate safety of individual and safe mobility of others.

Road safety is a safety measure to reduce the risk of road accidents and road side injury because of the mistakes of people while driving on the road. We cannot count the daily road side accidents and death of people because of the driving mistakes and lack of road traffic rules followers. Every person going on the road has risk of injury or death. Such as pedestrians, motorists, cyclists, passengers, etc.

Everyone needs to be well aware of the road traffic rules especially children and young people who are at significant road accident risks. According to the statistics (World Health Organization, 2008), it is found that most of the hospitalization cases and leading cause of death are because of the road trauma.

Road safety is very necessary while being on the road and must know by all because road accidents are the leading cause of death. Everyone should learn the road traffic and safety rules at a very early age to perform safer behaviours in the later life. Following are the road safety rules:

- Everyone going on the road (especially drivers) must be to the left and let other vehicles pass on the opposite direction to pass.
- Drivers should be in slow speed while bending or turning on the roads.
- Take extra precaution while going on the over-crowded roads and road junctions.
- Bikers or people using two wheel vehicles must wear helmets of superior quality otherwise they should never go on the road without helmet.
- Speeds of the vehicles should be within the speed limit and slow especially in the areas of school, hospital, colony, etc.
- Every vehicle on the road should maintain the right distance among them to avoid collisions and accidents.

• Everyone using road should be well aware of the road signs and must follow rules.

• All the road safety rules and regulations must be in mind while travelling.

Road Transport Scenario in India:

Road safety is a health, development as well as a complex issue of concern, considering its magnitude and gravity and the consequent negative impacts on the economy, public health and the general welfare of the people, particularly those with low income. The safety of road users is primarily the responsibility of the concerned State Government. However, this Ministry has taken several steps during the year to improve road safety for road users which are as under:

- 1. It is ensured that road safety is the integral part of road design at planning stage.
- 2. Various steps to enhance road safety such as road furniture, road markings/road signs, introduction of Highway Traffic Management System using Intelligent Transport System, enhancement of discipline among contractors during construction, road safety audit on selected stretches, have been undertaken by National Highways Authority of India.
- 3. Refresher training to Heavy Motor Vehicle drivers in the unorganized sector being implemented by the Ministry since 1997-98 under plan activities.
- 4. Setting up of Driving Training School in the States by Ministry of Road Transport and Highways.
- 5. A massive public awareness campaign was carried out in the electronic/print media through the Directorate of Advertising and Visual Publicity (DAVP), Doordarshan and All India Radio. Publicity material like calendars, posters, book on road signs, children activity book and mouse-pad etc. were also supplied to Transport and Police Authorities in States/Union Territories and Schools for widespread distribution.
- 6. Providing cranes and ambulances to various State Governments/NGOs under National Highway Accident Relief Service Scheme. So far, 347 cranes, 106 small/medium sized cranes and 579 ambulances have been sanctioned. 140 ambulances are also being provided to the hospitals along National Highways identified by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare. National Highways Authority of India also provides ambulances at a distance of 50 Km. on each of its completed stretches of National Highways under its Operation & Maintenance contracts.
- 7. The first National Workshop on road safety was held at New Delhi on 03.04.2012. The theme was "improving the safety of most vulnerable road users". The meeting was attended by the Transport Ministers from the States, Pr. Secretaries/Secretaries/Commissioners of Transport and DG/IG of Police of States/UTs.

As per the deliberations in the 12th meeting of the National Road Safety Council held on 25th March, 2011, the Ministry formed five separate working groups on four E's of Road Safety viz

- (i) Education
- (ii) Enforcement

(iii) Engineering (road as well as vehicles) and

(iv) Emergence care to deliberate in detail and submit their recommendations on short term and long term measures for immediate implementation so as to curb road accident in the country.

NRSC in its 13th meeting held on 29th February, 2012 deliberated on the recommendations of all the five working groups. A synthesis report containing all the major recommendations of five Working Groups has been uploaded on the Ministry's website.

Accident Causes & Remedies:

The number of deaths due to road accidents in India is indeed a cause for worry. The scenario is very dismal with more than 1,37,000 people succumbing to injuries from road accidents. This figure is more than four times the annual death toll from terrorism. Reports show that a person dies in a road accident every four minutes. At least 5 deaths are reported due to road accidents everyday in Delhi and 16 children die every day in India because of the same reason. The reports also show that while two-wheelers account for 30% of the accidents, the new vehicles with the state-of-art safety features are involved in a bulk of accidents.



Reasons


- **Bad Roads:** India is said to be the fastest developing country after China. The nation is performing extremely well in fields such as education, industrialization and fashion. However the conditions of the roads, be it the metropolitans, towns or villages, act as a major pothole in India's complete progress. According to the Road Accident Report for 2014 prepared by the road transport and highways ministry, 75,000 people have been killed because of the killer roads of India.
- **Speeding:** Another major factor contributing to the increased number of road accidents is speeding. The public fails to follow the speed limits, especially on the highway. This has resulted in 41% of the total deaths due to road accidents in India in 2014.
- **Overloaded vehicles:** Be it passengers or goods, overloaded vehicles are also a major cause for accidents in India. It becomes difficult to control an overloaded vehicle. When a vehicle is carrying goods such as protruding steel rods, the result of an accident is even worse. Overloaded vehicles have accounted for 36,543 deaths in 2014.
- **Drunken driving:** Even though driving under the influence of alcohol is strictly prohibited, many flaunt this rule, which at times results in road accidents. Even if the person under the influence of alcohol walks away safe from the scene of the accident due to the safety features of the car, the pedestrians and smaller vehicles involved in the accidents are not so lucky.

- **Helmets:** Two-wheelers account for 30% of the road accidents in India. Wearing a helmet can reduce the risk of severe injury by 72% and the risk of death by 39%, according to the World Health Organisation. But only a handful of the cities in India have made the use of helmets mandatory.
- Safer road for vehicles, not people: While India has been upgrading its highways since 2000, with dividers, four-lane and six-lane roads and expressways, the design does not cater to the requirements of pedestrians, cyclists, two-wheelers, animal carts and other slow-moving traffic.


Road Accident Investigation & Investigation Methods

The following steps should be taken upon arrival at the scene of the accident. While enrooted to the scene, the officer should obtain as much preliminary information as Possible concerning the accident. Such information includes:

- 1. Location
- 2. Time of notification
- 3. Who notified the officer and how
- 4. Weather and visibility conditions
- 5. General information as to seriousness of the accident injuries, hit and run,
- 6. Amount of traffic congestion, etc.
- 7. Whether or not additional support is proceeding to the scene, such as wrecker,
- 8. ambulance, or additional Police patrols
- 9. By obtaining such information prior to arrival at the scene, the investigators may more quickly and efficiently respond to the needs of the situation.



Road Safety Education:



Keeping your kids safe at all times can be tricky when you cannot be with them always. Parents ensure the safety of their child at home, and teachers or caretakers are responsible for the kid's safety at school. But who keeps them safe on the road? Whether your children walk to school or take the bus, they should be taught about the rules to stay safe on roads.

Importance of Road Safety Rules and Regulations:

Unlike adults, children do not have the maturity to know what to do and what not, when walking on the roads. Without adult supervision and proper knowledge of road safety rules, children can put themselves at risk. According to a National Highway Traffic Safety Administration report for 2014, 3% of the people who died due to road accidents were children. Statistics also show that 480 kids were injured every day due to road accidents in the same year. What's more disturbing is that of the 4,884 pedestrians who were killed in road accidents, 207 were kids.

When it comes to the safety of your children, you should not compromise. Teach about road safety for children as soon as they are old enough to step out of the house. Ensure that they understand what you are saying by practicing it with them.

13 Rules to Ensure Road Safety:



1. Know Your Signals

Help your kid learn about the traffic lights and signs, and what each color indicates.

- Green means 'go': Only when the signal turns 'green', vehicles move ahead.
- Red means to 'stop': When the signal turns red, all the vehicles have to stop.
- Yellow means to slow down: When the signal turns yellow, vehicles should slow down and prepare to stop.
- The 'Walk' or a walking man symbol at intersections is for pedestrians. Cross the road only if these signs turn green. But look to the left and right to ensure no vehicles are approaching.
- Never cross the road if the sign says 'Don't Walk' or if the walking man symbol turns red.

Sometimes a hand symbol is used instead of the walking man or 'Walk' signals. Tell your kid about that too. If there are other symbols for pedestrians, you should make it a point to let them know. Gradually, teach your children about the other essential traffic signals they should know.

2. Stop, Look, And Cross

Your child may have to walk to school or the bus stop and back. They may only have to cross the street after the school bus drops them off. Even if they don't, they may have to cross the street to get

to a friend's house or a neighbour's. Whatever the case is, you should teach your kids to cross the road safely. Here's how you can help them learn.

Always look for signals and use the pedestrian crossing to cross the road. In the absence of such markings, here is what you should do:

- Look to your right and then to the left to see if there are any approaching vehicles.
- If yes, wait for the vehicle to pass and then cross the road.
- Never cross at bends.
- Never cross between stationary vehicles.

Adults should always accompany children aged less than six and hold their hand when crossing the street.

3. Pay Attention – Listen

Teach your kids that they may not always be able to see an oncoming vehicle, especially if they are standing near a bend. Therefore, they should listen to know if a vehicle is approaching. Cars and other vehicles on the road often use the "horn" at bends and at unmanned intersections to indicate that they are nearing. Tell your children:

- If they hear a horn, stop and look to the left and right to see if any vehicle is approaching.
- Listen for engine sounds nearby to know if there is a moving vehicle explain how a loud noise indicates the vehicle is nearby, and a faint sound means it is away.

4. Don't Run On Roads

Children may not always have patience and may tend to run across the street to get to the other side. They may also run along the road in your neighbourhood while playing. Tell your kids never to run across or along the road. Children can get distracted easily and leave their guardian's hand to run or sprint away.

5. Always Use Sidewalks

Teach your kids to use the sidewalk when walking on the road. Set an example for them by using the walking paths yourself. Whether it is a busy street or not, encourage your kid to use the sidewalk to stay safe on the road.

6. Crossroads and Pedestrian Crossing

Kids have a tendency just to sprint across the street, anywhere they like. That can be dangerous as passing vehicles do not slow down unless there is a signal or a crossroad. Tell your kids to cross only at an intersection and use the pedestrian crossing. If they are in a small neighbourhood where there is no crossroad or marked crossing, they should follow the rules mentioned above.

Lessons on pedestrian safety for kids are important and should be included in school curriculum as well.

7. Never Stick Hands outside the Vehicle

Kids tend to put their hands out of the school bus even when it is moving. Some of them may even

put their head out to look back and wave. This is common with students taking the school bus. It may seem like a fun idea but sticking hands or head out of a moving vehicle can be highly dangerous. If children are not careful, they could be hit by vehicles approaching from the opposite direction.

8. Never Cross Road at Bends

Bends are the blind spots for motorists. When you cross at a bend, you do not give the vehicle drivers enough time to spot you and stop the car. Tell your kid never to cross at a bend as that can increase the chances of them getting hurt.

9. Staying Safe on A Bicycle

If you have an older kid who rides his bike to school or around the neighbourhood, make sure he is aware of and follows the following cycling rules to stay safe on the road.

- Always wear a helmet when riding a bike.
- Check if the bicycle is in working condition before using it check for breaks and light, if using at night.
- Always use the bicycle lane. In its absence, ride the bike on extreme right or left side (whichever is right in your country) of the road and move along with traffic. Keep your eyes and ears open to make way for larger and faster vehicles behind you.
- Always use a light in areas with poor visibility and at night, to be easily noticed by motorists.

Do not allow kids to ride a cycle on busy streets without parental supervision.

10. Staying Safe inside A Moving Vehicle

In a moving car, you can make sure that your kid is safe with the help of a car seat or seat belts. To see that they are safe in a moving vehicle without you, make sure they learn and follow these simple rules:

- Never stand inside a moving vehicle, especially a school bus or van.
- Students should not move around inside a moving school bus.
- Stay seated and holds on to the hard rail inside the bus for support, until the vehicle comes to a stop.
- Do not put any part of the body outside the window of a moving vehicle.

11. Always Get Out At the Curb Side

If your kid takes the school bus every day, help them remember these safety tips.

- Start early and be on time to avoid running for the bus.
- Always stand in the queue when boarding and alighting the bus.
- Always get off the curb side when getting off a car or the bus to prevent being an obstruction to the other vehicles on the road.

12. Be Seen, Stay Safe

Dressing in black may be a bad idea when you want to walk at night. It is important that vehicle drivers notice you if you want to stay safe. To be seen:

- Wear light colored clothes or reflective material when walking or biking at night.
- Wear bright clothes during the day.
- Wave your hand if you want to indicate your presence to an incoming vehicle.

13. Don't Rush

Children can get excited and rush in an attempt to get to a place or meet someone. That can be dangerous. Teach your kids to:

- Not rush when getting into or off a vehicle as it can be hazardous.
- Not get distracted or suddenly drag the parent or guardian in a particular direction as this can throw the adult off guard.
- Stay calm and do not rush when walking on the street.
- Not open the car doors suddenly as they them get into a habit of opening the doors only after you say so.
- Do not play in the bus bay or on the roads.










